OKAIMH's 2019 Fall Conference presents *Facilitating Attuned Interactions (FAN)* with Linda Gilkerson, founder of the Fussy Baby Network at Erikson Institute and developer of the FAN model for effective parent engagement and reflective practice in home visiting. FAN is also being adapted to child care, early childhood education, pediatrics and child welfare, and is aligned with the Alliance for the Advancement of Infant Mental Health's *Endorsement for the Culturally Sensitive, Relationship-based Practice Promoting Infant Mental Health*.

Practitioners and Supervisors will be introduced to the FAN conceptual framework and gain an overview of practical tools that help:

- Focus on and tailoring your responses to a parent's urgent concerns
- Recognize your internal sense of regulation or dysregulation
- Develop strategies to feel more balanced in activating situations
